A system level approach - no dead ends

Setting the scene - case Finland

- Disruption, ageing, birthrate, lack of skilled workforce...
- Early childhood education and care
- Basic education – system leaking
- A reform in VET(>50% adults)
- Entry to HE "blocked"
 - goal 50% (25-34 y), currently 41%
 - free education, economic recession, accumulation of education
 - entrance exam, 50%
 - matriculation exam 50%, role of math!
